- Health and Safety Volunteers** advance the mission of the Red Cross by teaching people how to respond to emergencies. Our Volunteer Instructors teach thousands of students each year the basics of CPR, First Aid and the basics of Babysitting.
- Disaster Action Team (DAT) Volunteers** are the Volunteers at the Red Cross who answer the call for help at 3 AM to drive 45 miles through the driving sleet to put a Teddy bear into the hands of a tearful 4-year-old girl who has just lost her puppy dog in the fire that is destroying her family's home as she watches. DAT members provide immediate assistance, both emotional and financial, to the victims of disasters (often house fires).
- Volunteer Recruitment Volunteers** help recruit the next Red Cross volunteers! Telling them what it feels like, telling your story, and helping them navigate this application packet.
- Disaster Services Volunteers** deploy to National Disasters – often for weeks at a time, often in adverse condition – to provide a wide array of services ranging from Staff Support, to Damage Assessment, to Sheltering and Feeding, to Individual Client Casework and Assistance.
- Military (AFES) Volunteers** provide services to the Armed Forces 24/7/365 by helping send emergency messages from military families to service members around the globe.
- Fundraising Volunteers** raise the money that we distribute to help people with their immediate emergency needs following a disaster throughout southeast Missouri.
